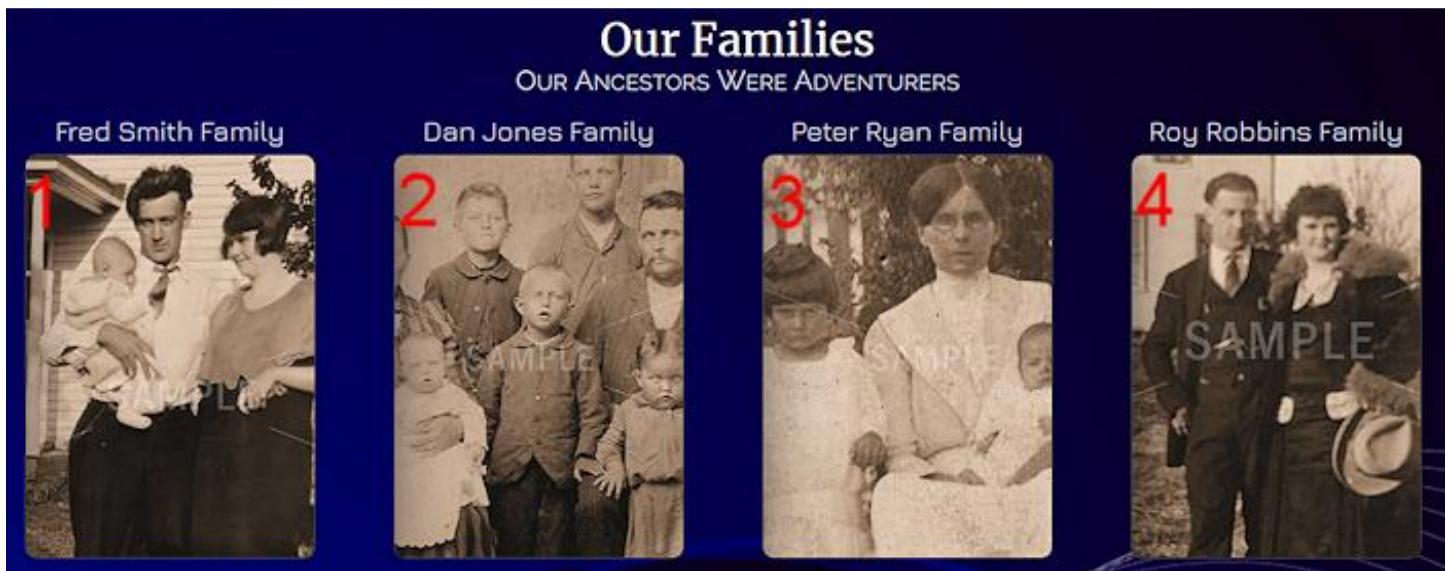

The Image Slider Boxes use identical coding for each entry, differentiated only by its number.



Hints for a well-styled Ancestor Slider Boxes

For the best appearance, use images that are all 260px by 350px. Resize your images as needed. This free online program is available if you don't currently have an image editor: <https://www.webresizer.com/>. It works well, otherwise, use your favorite image editor.

Ensure your text remains brief. Aim to keep the text section a similar length on each box. Since you are already have a link to the ancestor, extensive text is not necessary.

Featurette Coding

Featurette title is the name of the family above the image – Fred Smith Family

Featurette name is the shortened name seen on the mouseover – Fred & Mary

Featurette first line is the short line – Born 1862 – there is an underline after the text

Featurette second line is the 2nd short line – Married Ellie Capon Had 5 Children: Susan

Featurette image is the image for the slider box

Featurette person ID – links the person with the image

Featurette tree ID – designates the tree
