

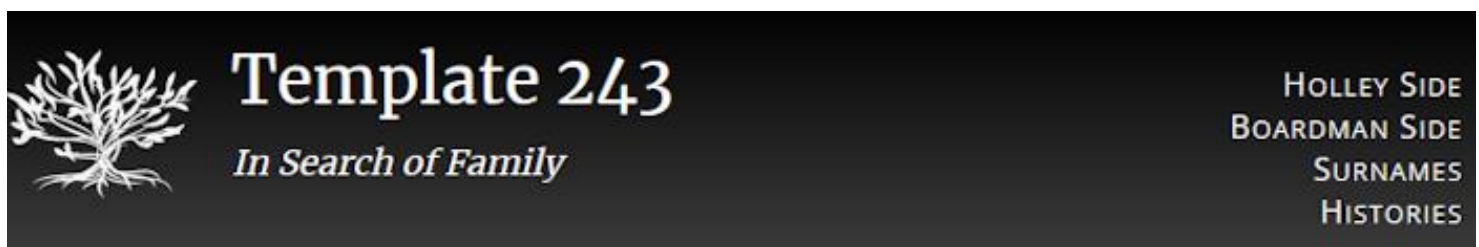

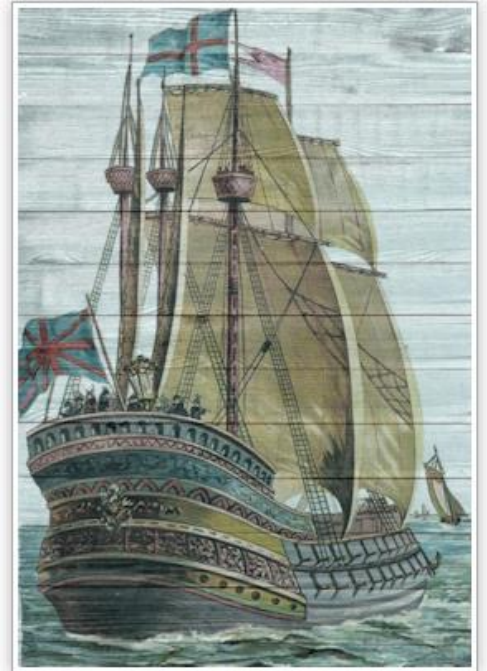
The Chosen
